



God Always Wins

Scope & Sequence

God Always Wins is an evangelistic study for children on the greatness of God in salvation. The purpose of *God Always Wins* is to first help children see that God wins over everyone and everything. Second, the lessons encourage children not only to want to be on God's side, but also to give them with an understanding of how that is possible. The study contains five lessons which present God as greater than all and most important—there is no one like God.

Lesson 1: God Wins Over Kings and Armies

Various Passages

God is greater than anyone.

- ▶ Through the examination of four biblical events (the 10 Plagues, Israel versus the Amorites, Israel defeats Midian, and Nebuchadnezzar's humiliation) children will see that God wins at everything He does, all the time. The kings and armies of the world cannot resist God. He is greater than all the kings of the world.

Memory Verse: Isaiah 46:9b

Lesson 2: God Wins Over All Gods

Elijah and the Prophets of Baal (1 Kings 18)

God is more powerful than all the gods.

- ▶ In this lesson, students will see that God is the one true God and wins over all gods. Other gods are powerless, and it is easy for God to win because nothing is too hard for Him. Children will also learn that God deserves to be in first place; it is wrong to place anything before God.

Memory Verse: Psalm 135:5

Lesson 3: God Wins Over Satan, Death, and Sin

Various Passages

God is the only One who can fix the sin problem.

- ▶ All people have a sin problem. In this lesson students will learn that Jesus died to free people from Satan, death, and sin because He is more powerful than these things—He is the winner over Satan, death, and sin. Children learn that God wins even when it looks like He is losing.

Memory Verses: John 1:29b

Lesson 4: God Wins in the End (The Last Battle)

The Rider on a White Horse (Revelation 19)

God will win over Satan and bring His children home with Him.

- ▶ Children will discover that there will be one, last, great battle in which Satan and all the forces of evil will battle against God, but God will win and bring His children home with Him. The last battle is good news for those who trust Christ but it is bad news for those who do not trust Christ.

Memory Verse: Revelation 19:1b

Lesson 5: Whose Side Are You On?

The Parable of the Great Banquet (Luke 14)

Being on God's side is the most important thing in life.

- ▶ The final lesson teaches that no one can serve two masters; you are either for God or you are against Him. If you are not on God's side, you can get on His side. God will help sinners get on His side.

Memory Verse: Matthew 6:24a
